

Get an uprising change of scene in Ronchamp and La Planche des Belles Filles ! You will discover the Vosges du Sud gems, where architecture meets beautiful nature and green countryside landscapes.

Between lakes and hills, from the chapel built by the famous architect Le Corbusier to La Planche des Belles Filles, the famous finish of three Tour de France stages and the only ski resort in Haute-Saône, discover the landscapes of a natural valley also rich in history. A strong mining heritage, a past linked to the abolition of slavery...

This guide will introduce you to the must-see places and sites less known to the public to make you have a great stay!

Cycling, bike riding, walking, hiking, fishing, swimming, visiting, discovering... Everyone will find something to do !

Hill Notre-Dame du Haut

The Hill Notre-Dame du Haut is a site of great historic, artistic and spiritual importance. In 1955, the Swiss architect Le Corbusier built his famous chapel there. This iconic building has been inscribed on the UNESCO listing in July 2016, along with 16 other sites around the world. It is the only UNESCO site in Haute-Saône.

In 1975, Jean Prouvé added the Bell Tower and more recently, in 2011, Renzo Piano worked on the site creating an architectural harmony between the Chapel, the Bell Tower and the monastery of Sainte-Claire and la Porterie.

Each year, nearly 70,000 visitors from all around the world come to Ronchamp to discover this amazing place, where beauty meets peace.

Marcel Maulini's Mining Museum

For 200 years, coal mining has modified the landscape and the history of Ronchamp and its surroundings. Marcel Maulini's Mining Museum helps visitors to understand organisation and social realities of those bygone days. Take the nearby marked trails to discover the origins of coal, extraction techniques used at the turn of the century and the uses of coal.

While going up to the Chapel, look on the right side of the road to see Sainte Marie mining shaft.

House of Negritude and Human Rights

Despite being far away from Africa and the Americas, with as sole image of a black man the picture of one of the Three Apostles in the local church, on the 19th of March 1789 the inhabitants of Champagney decided to ask for the abolition of slavery. They petitioned King Louis the 16th through the Register of Grievances, in the article 29.

The House is all about remembrance and was created around this article 29. There, you will find explanations about the context of the writing of this visionary, enlightened and courageous document, the story of slavery and contemporary forms of slavery.

You will discover, amongst other things, a reproduction of a slave ship as well as many African and Haitian artifacts illustrating the

negritude or values of the black people society. The museum is one of the 5 sites of the Abolition Trail.

La Planche des Belles Filles

La Planche des Belles Filles is a family summer and winter resort. It is famous worldwide since it has been the finish of 3 stages of the Tour de France (2012, 2014 and 2017).

SUMMER

In July and August, the resort is opened everyday and offers many activities : hikes, tubing, roll'herbe... In May, June and September, it is opened on weekends and bank holidays.

WINTER

In winter, the resort is opened from 9am to 5pm, on Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays / everyday during school holidays.



The resort offers 6 Alpine skiing pistes, 23km dedicated to cross-country skiing with possibility to connect the Ballon d'Alsace and snowshoes tracks. Children area: sledge piste and tubing.

A great hiking area !

Hiking is one of the visitors favorite activities in our area ! Our hiking trails go through beautiful forests, bucolic landscapes, views on the valley...

You can choose between 9 marked trails, from 3km to more than 15. They are available for free download on the english version of our website.

One hiking trail « Cités ouvrières » is all about the mining history of Ronchamp.

If you are looking for long distances hikes, you can join the GR59, a long national path going accross Franche-Comté to Izieu (Rhônes-Alpes).

If you are more into mountain bike, the Ballastières base will totally suit you ! 5 circuits, 122km of marked trails from easy to expert.

If you are a cycle lover, choose between 4 marked cycling trails on roads with low traffic density across our area, including the one going up to La Planche des Belles Filles (n°21) on the steps of the Tour de France stage. The Boucle des Champs (n°3) starts in Ronchamp and goes to Clairegoutte.

In the nearby Plateau des 1000 Etangs : Boucle de la Mer (n°4) and Boucle de la Petite Finlande (n°15).



Cycling and mountain biking



« Réseau VAE » is a certification label helping e-bike users to easily identify places offering free charge for their e-bike. Usually the certified places offer an activity (free or not) to wait while the bike is charging.

We created this certification label with the 1000 Etangs Tourist Office in 2018 to offer e-bike users a quality service and ensure they can discover the area without any trouble.

From May to September, hire an eBike (electric mountain bike) at the Ballastières Campsite.

Les Ballastières

Enjoy a swim at Les Ballastières lake !

Les Ballastières are composed of 2 lakes : one is dedicated to fishing and the other one is accessible from a free car park or from the campsite if you are a resident, and offers you a nice beach surrounded by trees and access to the water.

Swimming area monitored in July and August.

Fishing

The Rahin is a fishing river and, along with its tributaries, is well-known for its rich flora and fauna and wild population of trouts and graylings

You can buy your fishing licence at Ronchamp tourist office.

You can also go fishing in lakes. Some are managed by a local AAPPMA (National Fishing Federation), and some are private, you thus need a specific fishing licence. For instance, if you wish to fish at Les Ballastières lake, you need to buy your fishing licence at Les Ballastières campsite).



Champagney : lake and dam

Champagney lake, also called « Bassin de Champagney », is a gem quite unknown to the public. Its dam is an impressive work : 36m high, 785m long. The lake offers 7 km of river-banks.

From the dam, a spillway feeds a canal. If you follow it, it will take you to the Port of Frahier-et-Chatebier. On foot or by bike, this is an easy flat path, in a quiet area surrounded by the forest. It is a great activity to do with children !
